13:00: Meeting called to order by Base Commander Frank Gardner. Frank Gardner's opening statement was to welcome those that logged in and he reviewed the agenda for the meeting.

#### **REPORTS:**

<u>Commander's Corner</u>: Base Commander, Frank Gardner discussed three areas of concern for the base:

Frank thanked Edward Galaviz for ten years of dedicated service as commissioning base secretary and thanked Bill Hinds for stepping up to be the Chaplin. ### **New Business**

**Base Chaplin:** On 22 Jan 2021, in accordance with our base by-laws the Nat Greene Base Executive Board approved the appointment of Bill Hinds as our Base Chaplin. Jim Schenk vacated the position for health reasons. Executive board voted 6 yes votes and three executive board members did not reply. This meets the 2/3 majority for approval of the appointment. Bill Hinds thanked the base for the opportunity and stated, "he was humbled by our confidence in him."

**Base Secretary:** Effective 01 Feb 2021, Ed Galaviz resigned his post as Base Secretary. Ed served Nat Greene faithfully for more than ten years. Two items we discussed were support of the convention is a Sponsor Contribution from the base (individuals can also contribute) and whether or not we would advertise in the convention magazine. The base did not decide in this meeting to contribute any monies toward the convention and in line with actions will participate in a group advertisement of all North Caroline Bases if that is the decision made.
