National Honor Flight programs have been responsible for flying nearly 250,000 WWII, Korean, Cold War and Vietnam veterans to our nation's capitol to experience their memorials. **Triad Honor Flight Website for more information** Approximately 95 veterans have been served per flight. The remaining 90 seats are assigned to guardians, EMT's, team leaders, and a flight director.

Triad Honor Flights typically take by age unless there is a terminal illness, but flight are normally filled at least 30 days prior to flight day? We will contact veterans to see if they want to accept their spot and confirm. Please be patient with us and your application will remain on file until you are called.

A favorite story of faith comes to mind, and was related to me by John R Matthis (b 1920, d 2013), a WWII Submarine Brother and Tarheel base member who served in a variety of submarines, but this story is believed to be during his time on the USS Haddock SS 231 during one of the six (6) war patrols that John was a part of.

The USS Haddock was patrolling in and around Japan on the surface, with John and Captain Roy M.. Davenport on the bridge. Note: John was a Quartermaster during his Naval service.

As related to me...the lookouts spotted what appeared to be a Japanese Zero some distance away, but getting nearer to the Haddock. The Captain, looked around, then said to John..."John, as you know I have a very deep faith", and "I believe that the plane has not seen us and will veer away, would you stay with me on the bridge?"

John did not hesitate to agree to stay on the bridge, despite the impending danger that could be inflicted by the plane.

Time passed, and, by the grace of God, the Father Almighty the plane did indeed veer away and gave no indication that the pilot had seen the submarine.


This story shows the faith that both the Captain and John had. We all need to review our faith, and re-new our beliefs in these troubled times.

JANUARY

USS Scorpion	Lost sometime after January 5, 1944 with the loss of 76 men while on her
(SS-278)	4th war patrol in the YellowSea off China due to unknown causes. It is as-
	sumed she was sunk by a mine.
USS Argonaut	Lost on January 10, 1943 with the loss of 102 men while on her 3rd war
(SS-166)	patrol southwest of New Britain. While attacking a convoy, she torpedoed
	a Japanese destroyer who along with two other destroyers depth charged
	her. As she tried to surface, the destroyers sunk her by gun fire.
USS Swordfish	Lost on January 12, 1945 with the loss of 89 men while on her 13th war
(SS-193)	patrol by a possible Japanese surface attack or mine somewhere near Oki-
	nawa.
USS S-36	Lost on January 20, 1942 while on her 2nd war patrol when she ran
(SS-141)	aground on the Taka Bakang Reef in the Makassar Strait, east of Borneo
	and radioed for help. The entire crew was rescued by a Dutch launch boat
	after she was scuttled.
USS S-26	Lost on January 24, 1942 with the loss of 46 men while on her 2 nd war
(SS-131)	patrol in the Gulf of Panama, 14 miles west of San Jose Light. She was
	rammed by the USS Sturdy (PC-460) and sunk within seconds. The CO,
	XO and one lookout on the bridge were the only survivors.

USS Barbel	Lost on February 4, 1945 with the loss of 81 men while on her 4th war pa-
(SS-316)	trol during a Japanese air attack near the southern entrance to the Palawan
	Passage.
USS Shark I	Lost on February 11, 1942 with the loss of 59 men on her 1st war patrol af-
(SS-174)	ter receiving orders to proceed to Makassar Strait via the north coast of
	Celebes. Shark was the 1st US submarine sunk by enemy surface craft in
	the Pacific.
USS Amberjack	Lost on February 16, 1943 with the loss of 72 men while on her 3 rd war
(SS-219)	patrol when she was attacked by a Japanese patrol plane and surface craft
	off Rabaul in the Solomon Sea.
USS Grayback	Lost on February 26, 1944 with the loss of 80 men while on her 10th war
(SS-208)	patrol when she was attacked by Japanese air and surface craft off Okina-
	wa.

USS Trout	Lost on February 29, 1944 with the loss of 81 men on her 11th war patrol
(SS-202)	during a Japanese surface attack southeast of Okinawa in the Philippine
	Sea.

USS Perch	Lost on March 3, 1942 with no immediate loss of life while on her 1st
(SS-176)	war patrol. After two severe depth chargings in less than 200 feet of wa-

	scuttled her. Of the 59 men taken prisoner, 6 men died as POWs, and 53
	survived the war. Her wreckage has been located off the coast of Java.
USS Grampus	Lost on March 5, 1943 with the loss of 71 men while on her 6th war pa-
(SS-207)	trol. She was lost after engaging two Japanese Destroyers in Vella Gulf
	near the Solomon Islands.
USS H-1	Lost on March 12, 1920 with the loss of 4 men as they tried to swim to
(SS-28)	shore after grounding on a shoal off Santa Margarita Island, off the coast
	of Baja California, Mexico. Vestal (AR-4) pulled her off the rocks on the
	morning of March 24 th, only to have her sink 45 minutes later in some
	50 feet of water.
USS Triton	Lost on March 15, 1943 with the loss of 74 men while on her 6th war pa-
(SS-201)	trol when she was sunk during a fight with three Japanese destroyers
	north of the Admiralty Islands, which are north of New Guinea.
USS Kete	Lost on March 20, 1945 with the loss of 87 men at the end of her 2 nd
(SS-369)	war patrol between Okinawa and Midway, cause unknown. May have
	been sunk by a Japanese submarine that was subsequently lost.
USS F-4	Lost on March 25, 1915 with the loss of 21 men after she foundered 1.5
(SS-23)	miles off of Honolulu. Acid corrosion in the battery tank let seawater into
	the battery compartment, causing loss of control. F-4 was the first com-
	missioned U.S. submarine to be lost at sea. She was raised in August
	1915.
USS Tullibee	Lost on March 26, 1944 with the loss of 79 men while on her 4th war pa-
(SS-284)	trol. It's believed she was a victim of a circular run by one of her own tor-
	pedoes north of Palau. The lookout was the only survivor and he sur-
	vived the war as a Japanese prisoner.
USS Trigger	Lost on March 28, 1945 with the loss of 89 men while on her 12 th war
(SS-237)	patrol. She was lost during a combined attack by Japanese antisubmarine
	vessels and aircraft in the East China Sea.
